Single Gouge Auger Sets



Single Gouge Auger Sets are sets for core sampling tougher layers with minimal disturbance of soil for mapping, suitability reviews, root, fertilisation, clay and paleontological research.

Quick and virtually undisturbed sampling in soils to 1m

Advantages

- Will take samples in the toughest of soils
- Fast and easy to use
- Will cut through bricks and withstand stones
- Vitually undisturbed profile for analysis
- Made from toxic high tensile strength steel
- Easy to clean and very robust
- Available in 50cm 100cm lengths, 30mm diameter.

Disadvantages

• Cannot be used deeper than 1m.

Alternatives

There are many different augers capable of sampling different soil types and consistences. If you need to sample softer sediments or sludges we would recommend a Multi Sampler or Beeker Sampler, for sampling in Peat a Russian Corer Peat sampler may be preferred. All augers and samplers from Van Walt are unpainted and untreated so are therefore suitable for environmental research.
