Beeker Sampler

The Beeker Sampler is used to take undisturbed samples of sediments and submerged soils.



Undisturbed sampling of sludges and sediments

Advantages

- Virtually undisturbed sample
- With extension rods are capable of sampling to 5 metres
- Fast and clean samples that can be sampled layer by layer
- Clear sample tubes with visible profiles
- Original stratification of the sample is maintained
- Inflatable bladder in cutting shoe ensures even liquid samples are retained
- Easy to clean and very strong.

Disadvantages

- Relatively expensive.

Accessories

- 1.5m tubes available for longer sample
- Discharge and partitioning system with sample divider.

Specifications

- 1m or 1.5m sample.

Alternatives

A Multi Sampler is a cheaper alternative, Peat Samplers can also be used to sample in riverbeds.
