

Environment Policy Statement

The defined organisation structure specified environmental responsibilities and the provision of adequate resources shall allow for the effective implementation of the Policy and Integrated Management System throughout the organisation.

- co-ordination and co-operation with all relevant stakeholders including clients, enforcing authorities, public as appropriate
- responsible procurement, use, transfer and disposal of work equipment, goods and materials.

Employees at every level of the Organisation are expected to take all reasonable steps to safeguard the environment, and any other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions whilst at work.
