

Penetrograph



The **Penetrograph** is an instrument for the determination of the penetration resistance of the ground

Ideal for measuring disturbed layers and the effectiveness of compaction on different soils.

Advantages

- Self recording of continuous measurements plotted on a chart
- Clearly shows disturbed layers
- Will proof compaction situation
- Weather proof charts
- One-push measurement
- Ideal for contractors and agronomists
- Weather proof body.

Disadvantages

• Withdrawn from the ground by hand.

Accessories

• Supplied as a complete set, including spare parts and aluminium carrying case.

Specifications

- Made of stainless steel
- Records each layer of the ground profile up to 0.80 m on the chart
- Measuring range is up to 5000 kN/m² (=5 MPa)
- Suitable to depths up to 0.80 m.
